

# Success Story of PMAY

On April 2014, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi announced a flagship programme on Housing for All (HFA) under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (PMAY U) to envision a developed India with housing for every citizen by 2022, on eve of 75 years of Independence. Further on August 2015, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Odisha Shri. Naveen Pattanaik, announced AWAAS corroborating the national mission addressing housing requirements of urban poor in Odisha. Simultaneously "Policy for Housing for All" was published and "Odisha Urban Housing Mission" was established to manage the programme in the state.

Puri District mostly pastoral, has 4 Urban Local Bodies, 1 Municipality and 3 Notified Area Council. Puri city being largest of them and the only municipality in the District. Puri being one the prominent cities of India, known for its rich tradition of Lord Jagganath, has a population of 2 Lakhs with a decadal growth of 30%. As per SECC, 60,000 urban poor reside in the city.

As a part of PMAY -AWAAS, Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC) 1<sup>st</sup> phase selection process was initiated in April 2016, under which Puri Municipality submitted a Detailed Project Report (DPR) of 376 Beneficiaries further distributing the "Work Orders" on December 2016. 1<sup>st</sup> BLC house for the town was completed on September 2017.

For dissemination of information under PMAY- AWAAS BLC, Puri Municipality has adopted various Information education communication (IEC) tools such as distribution of pamphlets, Posters, advertisement banners at major road junctions and conducting the street play. Regular ward sabhas have been conducted to address public queries regarding the scheme and beneficiary selection process.

Regular geo-tagging has been carried out by Puri Municipality to monitor the progress of each stage of construction and support has been extended to every individual beneficiary. Following is the current status of BLC, as updated on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2017;

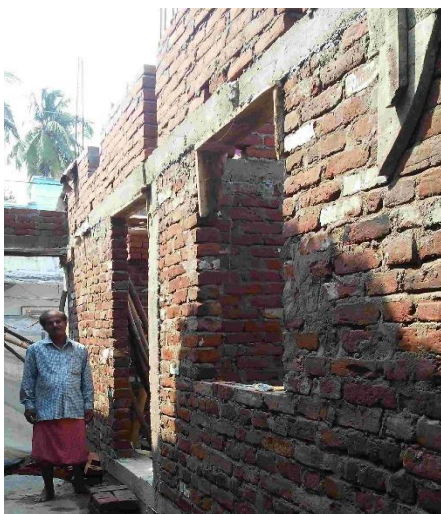
